**Bouncy Ben:** Big brown ears

**Clever Cat:** Yellow ears, face paint

**Dippy Duck:** Headband with picture of Dippy Duck's head

**Eddy Elephant:** Grey elephant ears

**Firefighter Fred:** Firefighter helmet, hose pipe, raincoat

**Golden Girl:** Green glasses, long ponytail made of yellow wool

**Harry Hat Man:** Hairy/wool green hat

**Impy Ink:** Ink bottle headband, rainbow clothes, a special pen

**Jumping Jim:** Jeans, jacket, juggling balls

**Kicking King:** Cape, crown

**Lucy Lamplight:** Lampshade as a hat, torch

**Munching Mike:** Cardboard monster mask covered in foil, or headband

**Noisy Nick:** Toy hammer and foil nails

**Oscar Orange:** Orange on a headband

**Peter Puppy:** Long droopy ears

**Quarrelsome Queen:** Crown and cape, umbrella

**Red Robot:** Red sack, cardboard box for headgear

**Sammy Snake:** Snake headband, toy snake

**Talking Tess:** A toy telephone, headphones

**Uppy Umbrella:** Umbrella headband, real colourful umbrella, small umbrella hat

**Vicky Violet:** Violet T-shirt, violets, flower necklace

**Walter Walrus:** Grey flippers

**Fix-it Max:** Toy tools, cap

**Yellow Yo-yo Man:** Yellow yo-yos, yellow clothes

**Zig Zag Zebra:** Ears on headband, black & white striped clothing

**Mr A:** Red and white striped apron

**Mr E:** Top hat featuring letter e

**Mr I:** Ice cream cone made of rolled-up paper

**Mr O:** White beard

**Mr U:** Official hat
