

# The Six Syllable Types Bookmark

## Instructions

1. Print this sheet onto some thick paper or card.
2. Carefully cut around the outside edge.
3. Fold in half (longest sides together) to create your bookmark!

## The Six Syllable Types

### Open syllable



1 vowel at the end



### Closed syllable



1 vowel + consonant(s)



### Magic e syllable



vowel + consonant+e



### Vowel Team syllable



2 vowels, 1 sound



### r-controlled syllable



vowel/s + r



### Consonant-le syllable



consonant+l+e

## Steps for Quick Coding

1. Dot the vowel(s).  
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2. Circle prefixes and suffixes.  
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3. Box the consonant digraphs.  
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4. Make a rail car for each syllable.  
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5. Identify the syllable type with its initial.  
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6. Code the vowel sounds.  
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7. Read the word.

## Syllable Division

- a. Divide between 2 consonants.  
picnic
- b. With 3 consonants divide after the first or second (keep digraphs or blends together).  
hundred
- c. Divide before 1 consonant or after it.  
tiger cabin
- d. Divide before consonant + le.  
maple
- e. In a few words, divide between 2 vowels.  
lion
