

# Dress Up – Dippy Duck

## Step-by-Step Craft Ideas

What you'll need:

- Dippy Duck template
- Yellow card (A2 cut down to a length that would fit around child's head – must be divisible by two)
- Yellow card (A4)
- Pink and orange paint
- Paper clips
- Glue
- Scissors

Recommended props (optional):

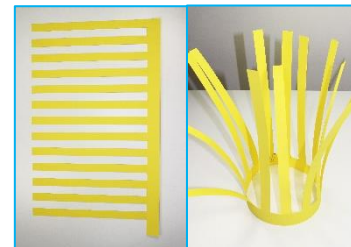
- Yellow t-shirt



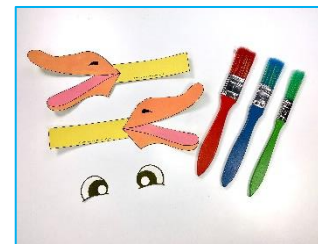
1. According to the template given, leaving a 3cm horizontal strip of card at the bottom, cut large piece of yellow card into 2cm thick vertical strips.



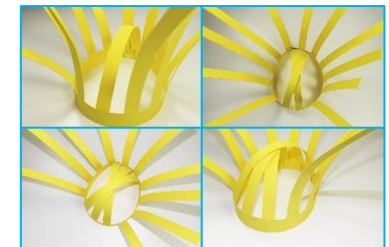
4. Use paper clips to keep pieces of card together as glue dries.



2. Cut off each second strip to create a pattern of strip, no strip, strip, etc. Attach bottom ends of the card together to create base of hat.



5. Print Dippy Duck's beak on yellow card and paint the mouth pink and beak orange. Once dried, glue two mouth pieces together, leaving the strip of yellow card unglued.

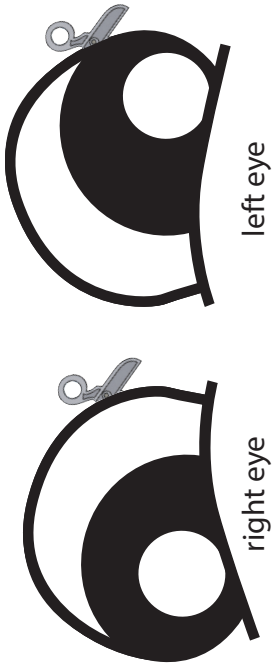
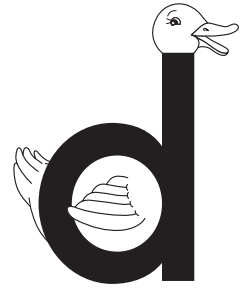


3. Start gluing strips to other side of the base in sequence.



6. Stick Dippy's eyes and beak to hat, using extra strips to attach beak to the hat's rim. Print wings on yellow card, cut out and stick to t-shirt.

Complete costume with letter shape template.

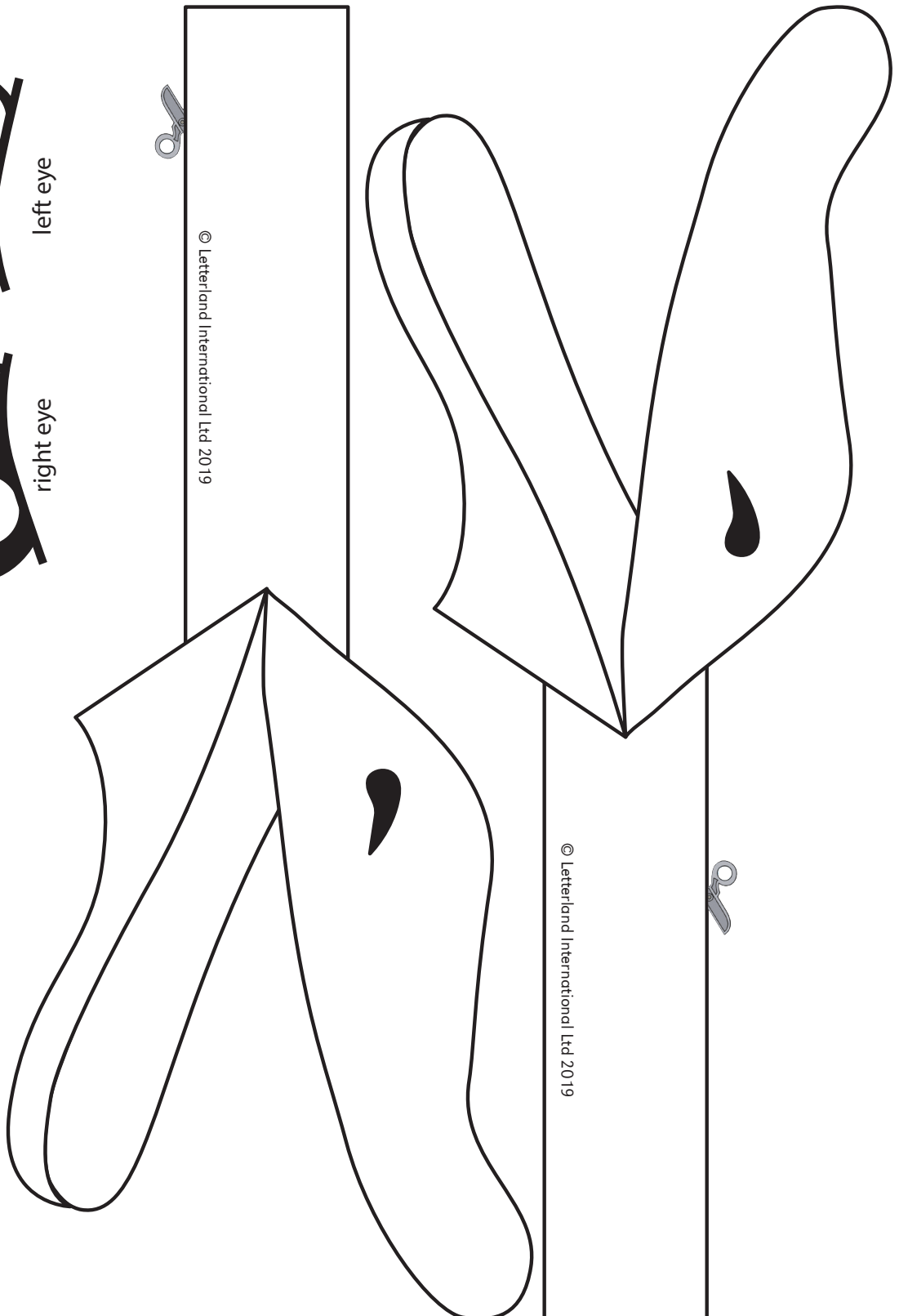


left eye

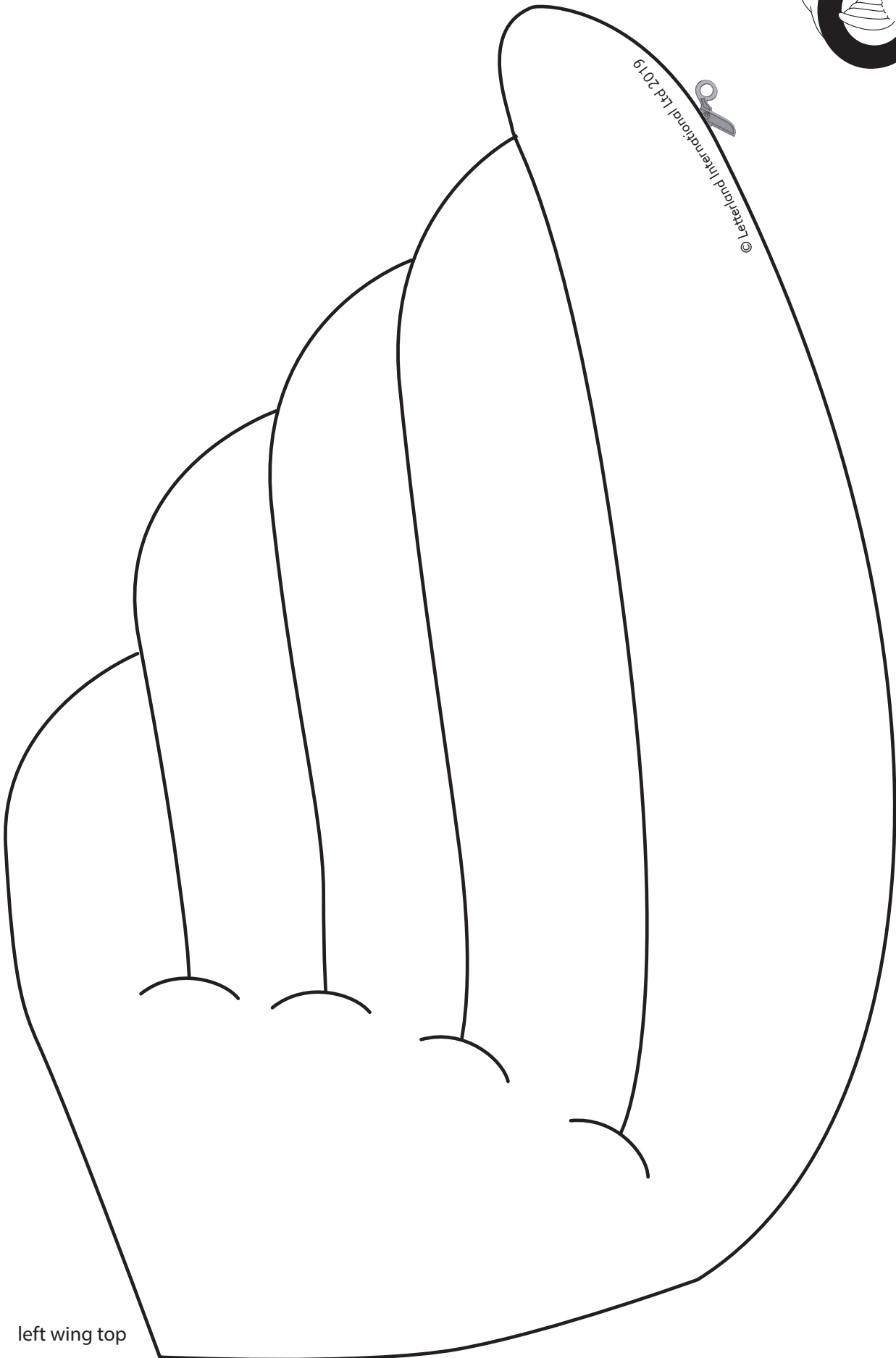
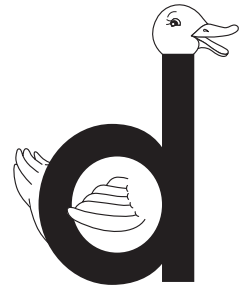
right eye



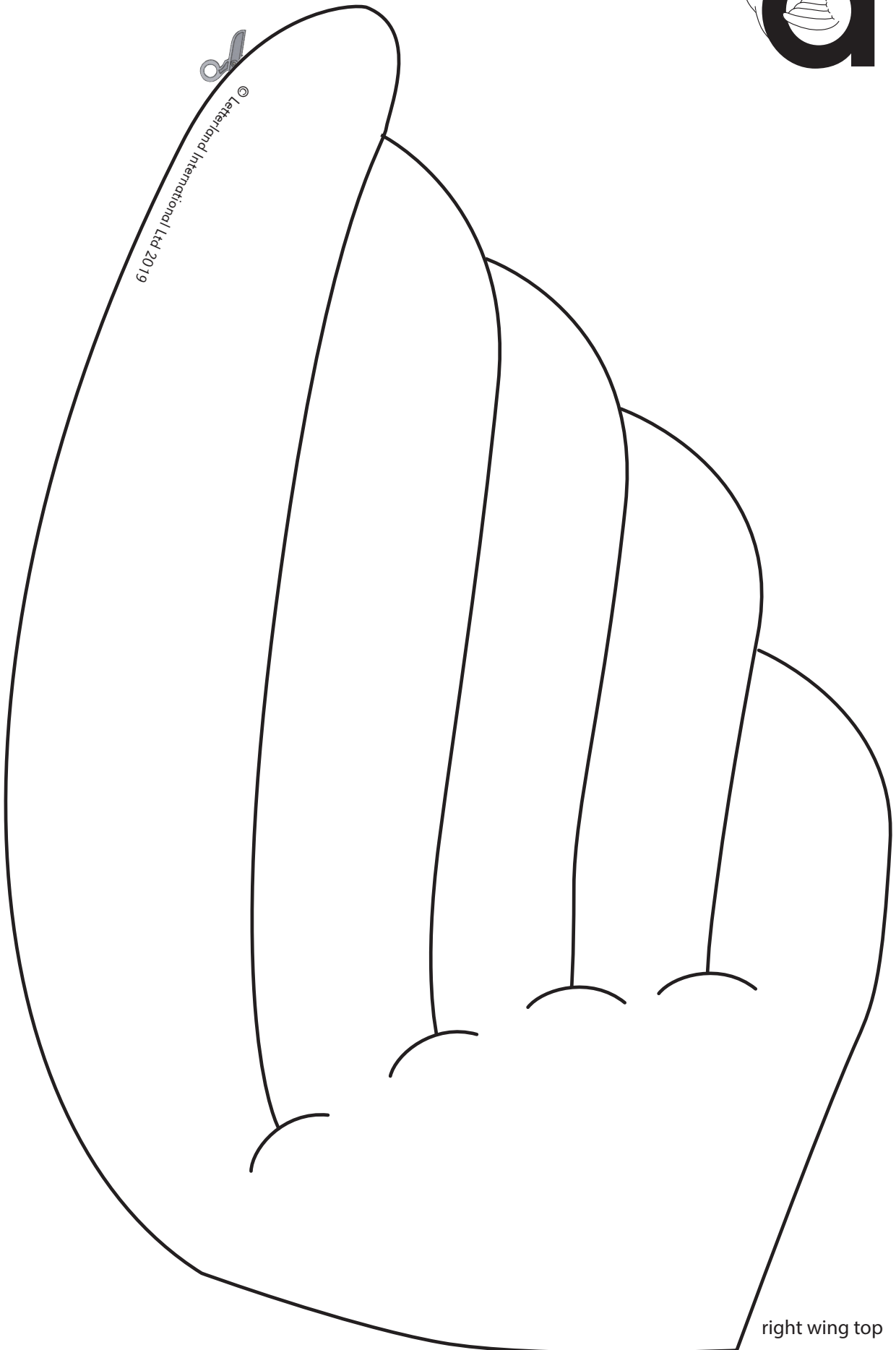
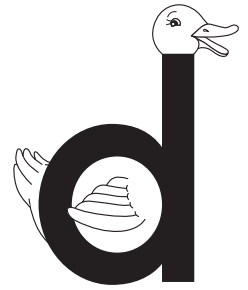
