

# Dress Up – Firefighter Fred

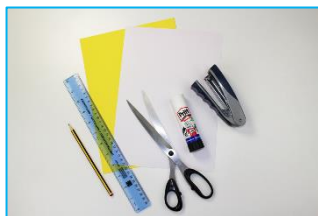
## Step-by-Step Craft Ideas

Letterland

What you'll need:

- 'FF' template
- Red waterproof jacket (colour can be adjusted depending on what your local firefighters wear)
- Yellow reflective tape
- Scissors
- Yellow card
- White card
- Ruler
- Stapler
- Glue
- Pencil



1. Print out FF hat template on the yellow card. Cut out.



2. Cut thick strips (approx. 4cm) from the white card. Measure to fit child's head. Staple/glue the ends together.



3. Glue yellow hat shape to the headband.



4. Stick two long strips of reflective tape all the way around chest/back area, and bottom of jacket. Add smaller strips around arms and short pieces across buttons/zipper.

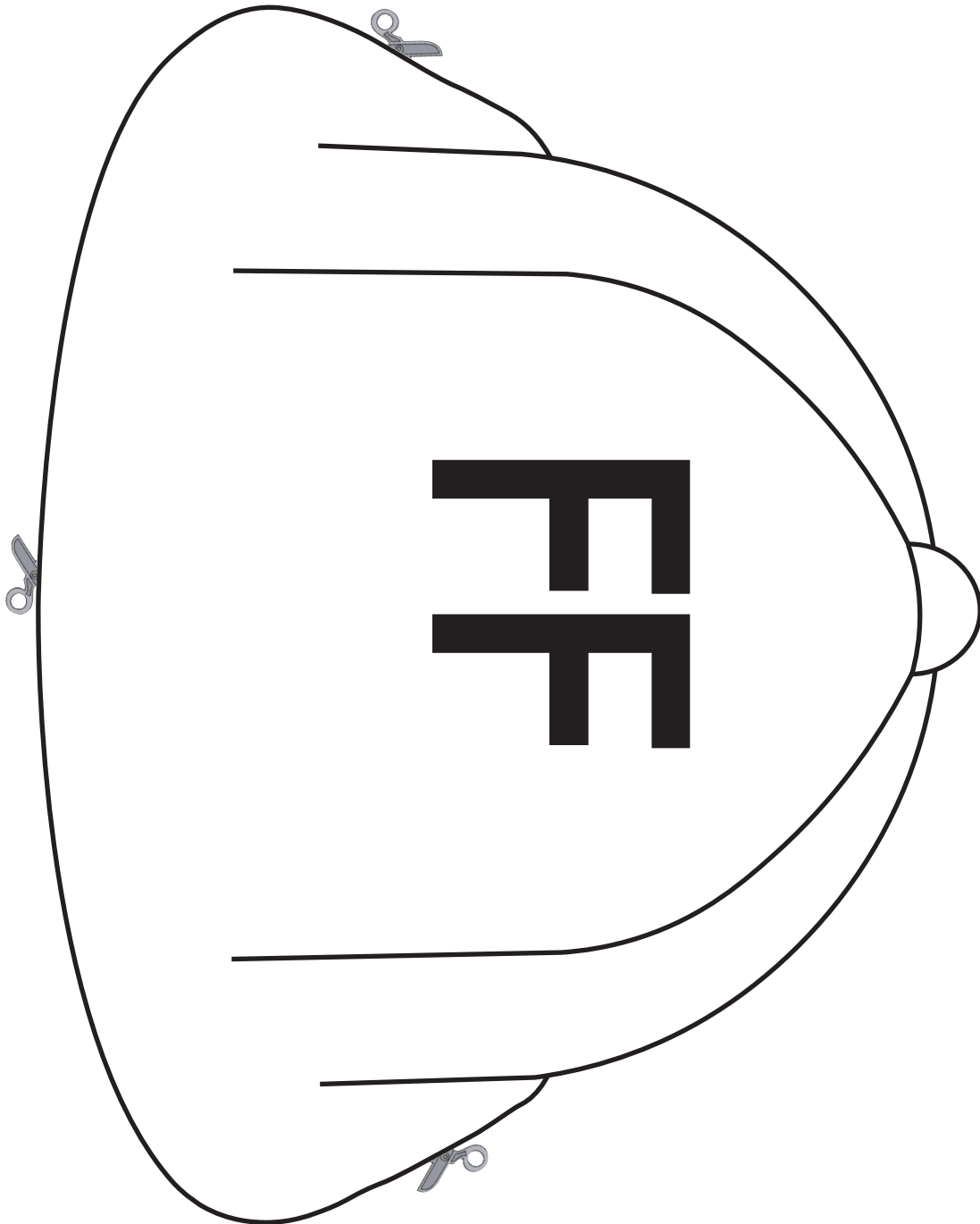
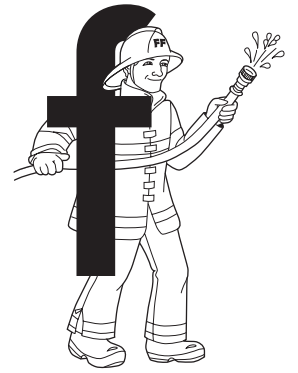


5. Cut Firefighter Fred's 'FF' out of the reflective tape and stick onto jacket.



6. Make sure to cut the tape across buttons/zipper so jacket can be taken on and off.

Complete costume with letter shape template.



Complete your costume by printing out this plain letter shape template, paint the letter blue, then cut it out and fix it to your top.
