What you'll need:

- A2 grey card
- Red card
- Ruler
- Stapler
- String
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape

Recommended props (optional):

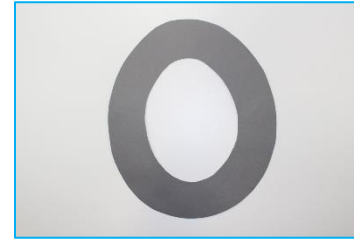
- Grey trousers and blazer
- White shirt
- Red waist coat
- Red bow tie
- Smart black shoes



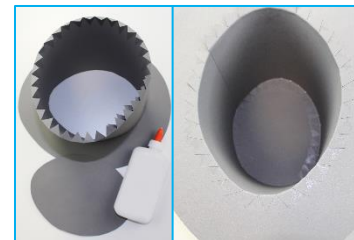
1. Use piece of string to measure the head of the person becoming Mr E. On grey card, tape opposite ends of the string to the card. Trace inside string with a pencil to create oval shape. Cut out.



4. Bend rectangle into cylinder shape and use glue to attach one end to the larger oval. Cut off any excess card from the cylinder shape.



2. Trace the oval onto second piece of grey card. Use ruler to make marks 2 inches around the first oval. Join marks to create larger oval. Cut out to create a donut shape.



5. Glue smaller oval shape to the top of the cylinder, creating a top hat. Use additional pieces of tape on the inside of the hat to secure the card.



3. Cut out a rectangle (about 18 x 60cm). Cut 1cm-deep triangles along the top and bottom of the 60cm edges.



6. Print off the letter 'e' template on red paper, cut out and glue onto the hat.
