

Activity Bank: Letterland Jingles

Objectives

- To complete an alliterative pattern.
- To listen for meaning in an oral sentence.

Materials

- *Vocabulary Cards* and/or **a-z** objects from a 'sound bag' (a bag containing objects starting or ending with target sounds).

Procedure

- Hand out *Vocabulary Cards* or sound bag objects to each child.
- Read out the alliterative jingles below, one at a time.
- The child holding a card or object that completes the pattern stands up and says the word. The class decides if the completed sentence makes sense.
