

# Activity Bank: Sort it Out!

## Objective

- To sort pictures according to target sounds.

## Materials

- A variety of pictures containing the target sounds.

## Procedure

### a) Whole-class activity

- Choose up to three target sounds and place pictures representing all three sounds in a box.
- Stick three 'pockets' on a flipchart or blackboard. Label the pockets with the Letterland pictograms representing the sounds.
- Select a child to pick a card from the box.
- The child names the picture aloud, identifies the target sound and puts the card in the appropriate pocket.
- The class decides if the card is in the correct pocket.

### b) Individual activity

- Provide children with their own page of the photocopyable pictures.
- Help them to make flaps on a piece of construction paper, as shown below.
- Children cut out the pictures one at a time, then stick each picture under the appropriate flap.
