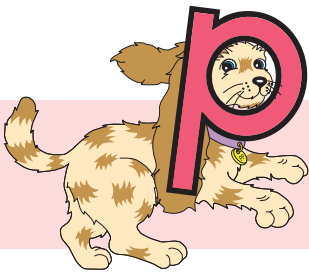


You will need

- Thick card or craft paper
- Potatoes
- Cookie cutters
- Paint
- Paper plates or small containers
- Glitter (optional)
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- String or ribbon

Instructions



1. Ask an adult to cut the potatoes in half (or into thick slices).
2. Using your cookie cutters, cut the potatoes into shapes. These will become your stamps!
3. Pour a little paint onto a paper plate. Dip your potato shapes in the paint and press onto your card. Leave plenty of space in between each shape, so they are easy to cut out when they are dry.
4. Leave your sheets of card to dry.

5. Cut around your pretty printed shapes. Make your tag any shape you like!
6. Write a name or festive phrase on your tag. There are some ideas at the bottom of this page.
7. Punch a hole in your gift tag. Thread your choice of string or ribbon through the hole.
8. Add your tag to a gift for a loved one!
