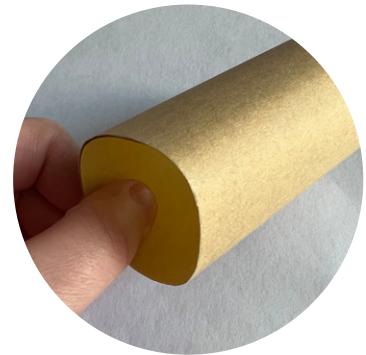
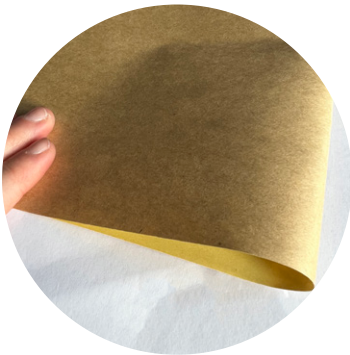


Rolled Paper Reindeer



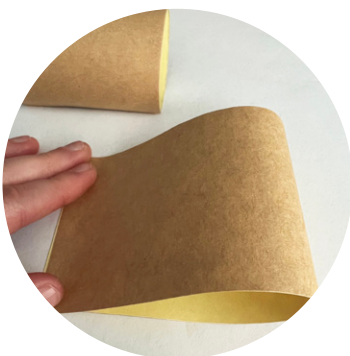
You will need

- Brown card
- Card (to stick him on!)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Stapler (optional)
- Googly eyes
- Little pom poms
- Marker pen
- Glitter (optional)



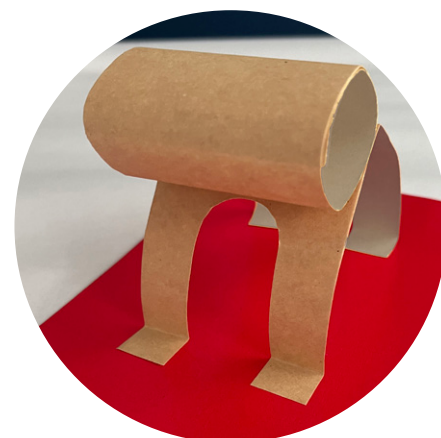
Instructions

1. Fold a sheet of brown card in half by bringing the short edges together. Cut in half so that you have two pieces. Take one of these pieces and fold it in half by bringing the long edges together. Cut along the fold so that you are left with two long, thin pieces.
2. Roll one of these long pieces of card up to create a tube. Secure with glue, or ask an adult to help you staple it together, and then set aside. This will be the reindeer's head.



3. Take your other length of card and fold it by bringing the short edges together. Draw an upside-down uppercase 'U' shape onto the folded card, and then carefully cut it out. Unfold to reveal your reindeer's body and legs!

4. Create the reindeer's feet by folding the bottom of the legs up as shown above.
5. Secure the feet to a piece of card, using some glue.
6. Attach the head to the body, and leave to dry.
7. You can now decorate your reindeer. Use a marker pen for the hooves, stick on a pair of googly eyes and a red nose, and cut out some antler shapes to add to the head. You could use some of your brown card offcuts to make a little tail.
