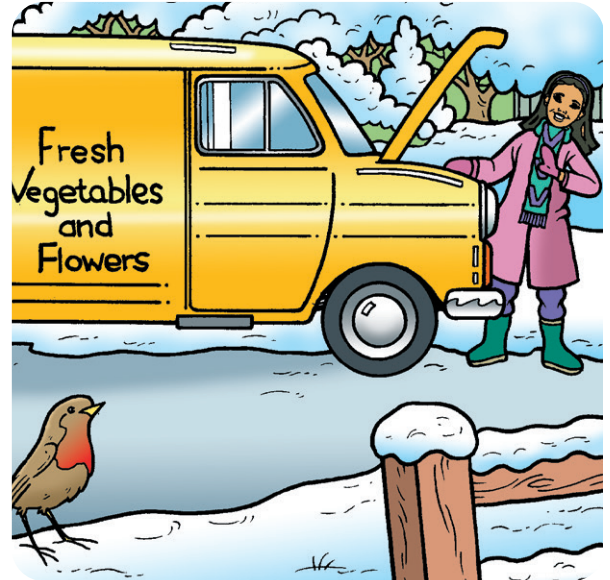




Vicky's Delivery

Who's helping Kicking King in the kitchen?

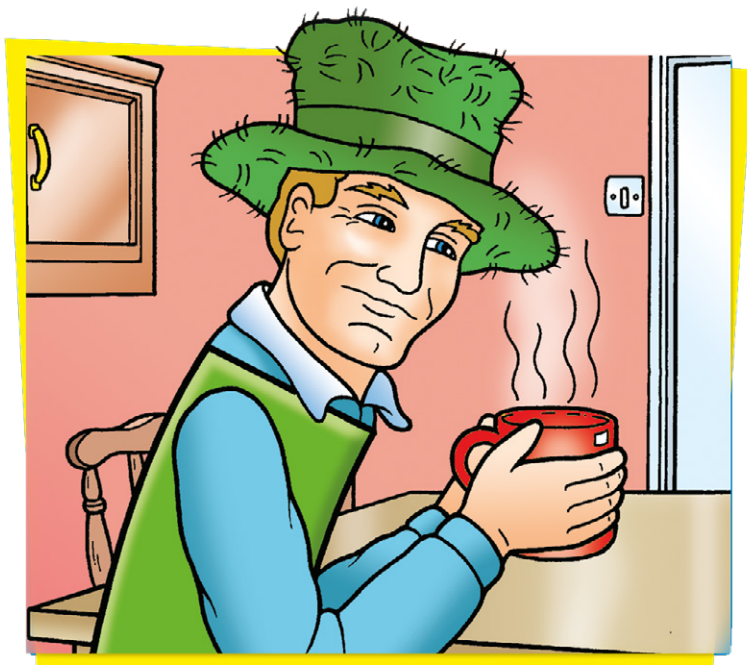


Clever Cat's Cocoa

“No,” laughed Harry Hat Man. “It’s too cold now!”

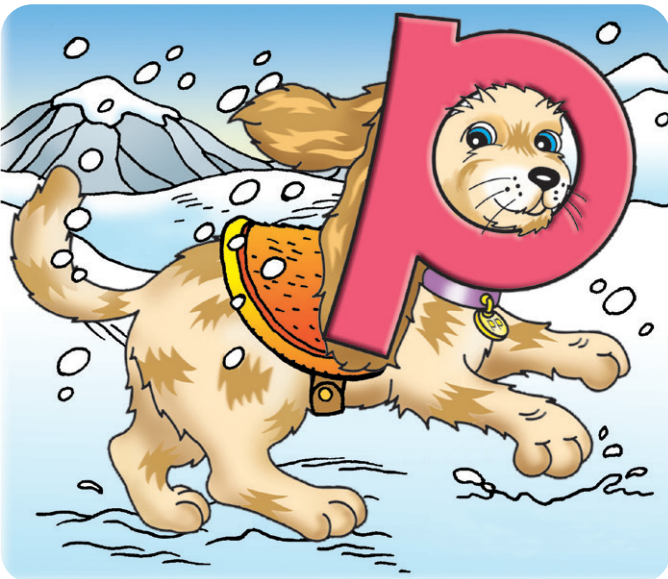




Snow Games
