

You will need

- Mason jar (or other clear jar)
- Distilled or bottled water
(we recommend using water with fewer impurities for the best result!)
- Clear Glue
- Hot Glue or another watertight adhesive
- Glitter
- Small waterproof toys

Instructions

1. Arrange your toys on the inside of the jar lid, and get an adult to help you glue them down. Make sure the adhesive is completely dry and the toy is very secure before you make your snowglobe.
2. Fill the jar with water, leaving just enough space to screw on the lid with all your items inside.
3. Add a squeeze or two of clear glue into the water. You can experiment with different amounts or even adding 1/2 tsp of vegetable glycerin. These additions make the water more viscous (or thick) which slows down the glitter as it travels through the water - letting the snow fall more slowly!
4. Add the glitter and screw the jar lid on tight. Get shaking!
