

You will need


- Paper

- Green and brown pencils







Instructions

- 1. Print the template or draw your own triangles and pots.
- 2. We've included a few example words, but you can add in 6 words of your own choice to practice.
- 3. Make sure to write the fully word in a pot, and each spelling pattern contained in the word in it's own triangle (as in the examples).
- 4. Cut them out and place the pots and triangles on a table.
- Children pick a pot and read the word. Then they pick the matching spelling patterns and stack them in the correct order to make the word.
- 6. To make it harder you could give multiple options for a word, using incorrect spelling patterns that make the same sound. Children then have to pick the spelling patterns that make the correct spelling.
- 7. Once they've got it correct, use the pencils to decorate your Christmas Tree Word!
