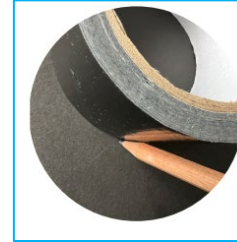
Letterland

What you'll need:

- 2 Paper plates
- Thick cardboard
- Black card
- String or yarn
- Scissors
- Duct tape
- Glue
- Paint and paintbrush



1. Paint the back of your paper plates (so they are upside down) and thick cardboard strip.



2. Draw around your duct tape roll onto the black card. Carefully cut out the circle shape.



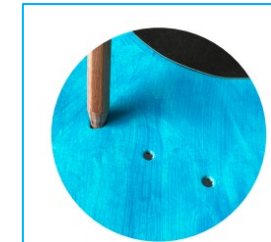
3. Once your painted pieces are dry, cut a small semi-circle from one of the paper plates.



4. Attach the cut plate to the round one - overlapping them slightly - and then stick your black card circle in the middle. This will look like the ukulele's sound hole



5. Secure your cardboard strip to the back of your ukulele base using some duct tape.



6. Ask a grown up to help you pierce three holes into the paper plate base using a pencil. They should be positioned underneath the black circle.

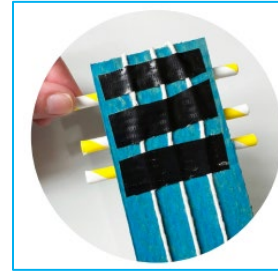

7. Thread your string or yarn through these holes, and stretch them right to the end of the ukulele handle. Use some tape on the back to hold them in place.



8. You can add some trimmed paper straws at the top of the neck to look like tuners, and more duct tape to give the impression of fret markers.
